SCHEDULE "CS"
COMMERCIAL SERVICE

AVAILABILITY:

Available for commercial, industrial, schools, churches, public buildings and three-phase service (excluding irrigation) requiring less than 50 kVA of transformer capacity within the Cooperative's service area, subject to established rules and regulations.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Alternating current, single and/or three-phase, 60 Hertz, at available secondary voltages.

MONTHLY RATE:

Customer Charge - All Customers -	\$32.50	X
All kWh/Month -	\$0.105005/kWh	X

DISTRIBUTED GENERATION NET METERING RATE RIDER:

When a Consumer installs a Distributed Generation System (DG) under this Rate Schedule the Consumer shall pay, on a monthly basis, the following Charges in addition to Charges and Rates stated above:

Billing and Meter Reading	\$8.49
Facilities Charge (DG System Nameplate kW/Month) for which power usage will be allowed at the foregoing rates	\$5.91/kW

DG System kW for solar shall be the Nameplate Capacity of solar panels installed. X

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of Ad Valorem, State and Federal Income Taxes) payable by the Cooperative and levied or assessed by any governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

IDLE SERVICE RATE:

Consumers classified under this rate schedule may retain existing electric facilities, excluding transformers, on their premises by paying \$25.00 per billing. X

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MINIMUM BILLING PERIOD CHARGES:

The billing period minimum charges shall be the highest of the following:

| 1) | \$32.50 per month, Plus DG Rate Rider as applicable, with no allowance kWh. | X |
| 2) | Minimum charges established in accordance with Line Extension Policy. No power allowed for the first \$32.50, plus DG Rate Rider as applicable. | X |
| 3) | All consumers requiring more than 10 kVA transformer capacity shall be charged an additional \$2.00 per kVA of transformer capacity in excess of 10 kVA for which power usage will be allowed at the foregoing rates. This charge shall be in addition to the customer charge of \$32.50 (no kWh allowance in customer charge or DG Rate Rider whichever is greater). | X |
| 4) | Minimum charges established by special contract between the consumer and the Cooperative for which power usage will be allowed at the foregoing rates. This charge shall be in addition to the customer charge of \$32.50 (no kWh allowance in customer charge plus DG Rate Rider as applicable). | X |

The minimum charges defined above shall not include applicable fuel and purchased power cost adjustment charges on kWh usage.

Capacity and energy allowances shall be made only during the billing period in which they occurred.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

The charges per billing period in the foregoing rates are net, and due and payable upon receipt. Charges are past due if not paid within twenty (20) days from the date on the bill.


SERVICE CHARGE:

A service charge of one and one-half percent (1-1/2%) per billing period or fraction thereof will be charged on all utility service bills and invoices which are delinquent.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- 1) The Cooperative's rules and regulations filed with the regulatory body shall apply.
- 2) All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment located on the load side of the metering point shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.

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- 3) The consumer's installation shall conform to the City, State and National Electrical Codes and Electrical Safety Codes.
- 4) Adequate and proper protection for applicant's motor including, but not limited to, properly rated heater coils in each phase of motor starting equipment.
- 5) Special conditions of service shall be covered by contract.

FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

The Cooperative shall, if the purchased power expense (excluding purchased power expense for any class of customers being directly billed purchased power) is increased or decreased above or below the base purchase power cost of \$0.070004/kWh sold, (excluding the kWh sold for any class of customers being directly billed purchased power), flow through to the users such increases or decreases, in accordance with 17.9.550 NMAC.

DEBT COST ADJUSTMENT:

Billings under this schedule may be increased or decreased by the change in current debt cost utilized in establishing the present rates, in accordance with 17.9.540.16 NMAC.

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
