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SCHEDULE "PS-EVCS"
POWER SERVICE EV CHARGER SERVICE

AVAILABILITY:

Available to commercial electric vehicle charging stations requiring 50 kVA or more of transformer capacity, selling electric vehicle charging service to the general public. To be considered for service under this tariff, only electric vehicle charging can be metered. All remaining services including but not limited to lighting and any buildings, must be separately metered and served under the tariff that would apply to their facilities.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Alternating current, single or three-phase, 60 Hertz, at available secondary voltages and separately metered.

NET RATE PER BILLING PERIOD: (or part thereof/service)

Customer Charge - All Customers-	\$15.47
Demand Charge -	\$ 5.46/kW

-PLUS-

All kWh per billing period@ \$0.374231/kWh on-peak

-PLUS-

All kWh per billing period@ \$0.079486/kWh off-peak

ON-PEAK AND OFF-PEAK PERIODS:

On-peak shall be June 15 through September 15. Summer on-peak hours shall be 2:00 PM through 6:00 PM (MST) every day. All other summer hours shall be off-peak hours.

METERING:

The Cooperative may install suitable demand and power factor measuring devices for billing under this schedule.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any fifteen-minute period during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as follows.

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of Ad Valorem, State and Federal Income Taxes) payable by the Cooperative and levied or assessed by any governmental authority on the public service

IDLE SERVICE RATE:

Consumers classified under this rate schedule may retain existing electric facilities (disconnected) on their premises by paying 60% of the established monthly minimum bill for each month thereafter.

MINIMUM CHARGES:

The monthly minimum charges shall be the highest of the following:

- 1) Minimum charges in accordance with Line Extension Policy or contract (no power allowed for the first \$15.47).
- 2) Or \$2.50 kVA of installed transformer capacity plus \$15.47 customer charge (no demand or energy allowed for the first \$15.47).
- 3) Minimum charges established by special contract between the consumer and the Cooperative for which power usage will be allowed at the foregoing rates. This charge shall be in addition to the customer charge of \$15.47.

The minimum charges as defined above shall not include applicable fuel and purchased power adjustment charges on kWh usage.

Capacity and energy allowances shall be made only during the billing period in which they occurred.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

The charges per billing period in the foregoing rates are net, and due and payable upon receipt. Charges are past due if not paid within twenty (20) days from the date on the bill.

SERVICE CHARGE:

A service charge of one and one-half percent (1-1/2%) per billing period or fraction thereof will be charged on all utility service bills and invoices which are delinquent.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- (1) The Cooperative's rules and regulations filed with the regulatory body shall apply.
- (2) All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment located on the load side of the metering point shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.

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- (3) The consumer's installation shall conform to the City, State and National Electrical Codes and Electrical Safety Codes.
- (4) The consumer shall not resell or share electric service with others.
- (5) Special conditions of service shall be covered by contract.

FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

The Cooperative shall, if the purchased power expense (excluding purchased power expense for any class of customers being directly billed purchased power) is increased or decreased above or below the base purchase power cost of \$0.070004/kWh sold, (excluding the kWh sold for any class of customers being directly billed purchased power), flow through to the users such increases or decreases, in accordance with 17.9.550 NMAC.

DEBT COST ADJUSTMENT:

Billings under this schedule may be increased or decreased by the change in current debt cost utilized in establishing the present rates, in accordance with 17.9.540.16 NMAC.

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
